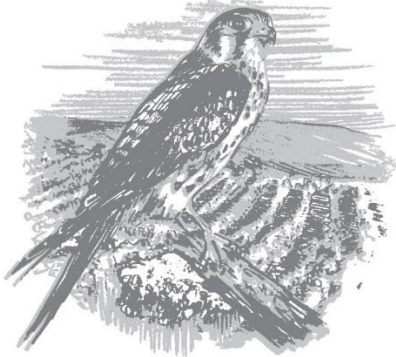




## 2011 Old Vine Cabernet Sauvignon

#### Vinification:

The grapes were harvested from Kestrel View Estate Vineyards and Olsen Estate Vineyards. The grapes were planted in 1972 and 1982 respectively, making them some of the oldest plantings in the state. These old vines are something special. They produce small intensely flavored crops, small canopies and small berries. The resulting wines are concentrated and elegant. They are truly something special.

#### Winemaker Notes:

The color is rich purple-plum. In the aroma you will be greeted by ripe black cherry, red currants, raspberry, pomegranate, blueberry jam, black pepper, caramelized sugar, toast, cedar and dried herbs. These intensified flavors, slowly glide across your palate as if in velvet slippers. The finish is elegant and refined, allowing sweet ripe fruit flavors to repeat and linger.
